

Here is the rule that has been listed.

B. Uniforms: Team competitors and coaches must appear in uniforms approved by the Commissioner for all matches and tournaments. If a bowler or coach is out of uniform, they will be given a verbal warning to make changes to comply with the uniform rule. If changes are not made, the coach or bowler **may be** disqualified from that event. Coaches not in uniform will not be allowed in the bowler's area.

- 1. Uniform shirts must have the official IHSB logo printed or embroidered on the shirt.** The logo may be on either breast or sleeve, but must be the same location for the whole team. The bowling shirt must have a butterfly collar or mock collar. Mock collar must be one inch up on the neck. All shirts must have finished sleeves for all competition. No writing on, or defacing of the bowling shirt will be permitted at any time. **No T-Shirts. Shirts must also be tucked in unless they are one of the styles designed to leave out.** Long sleeve shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt, but they must be the same color if worn by more than 1 player. Classic Products Corporation will be the designated vendor and will provide order forms for everyone. Teams may purchase their shirts from other vendors with written permission from the Commissioner to obtain and use the 'Trade-Marked Logo'.

The revised rule should read:

Shirts must also be tucked in unless they are one of the styles designed to leave out. Retro shirts do not have to be tucked in. Polo shirts must be tucked in at the start. If they come out as the result of bowling they may be left out. If a bowler intentionally pulls his/her shirt out, he/she will be asked to tuck it back in.
